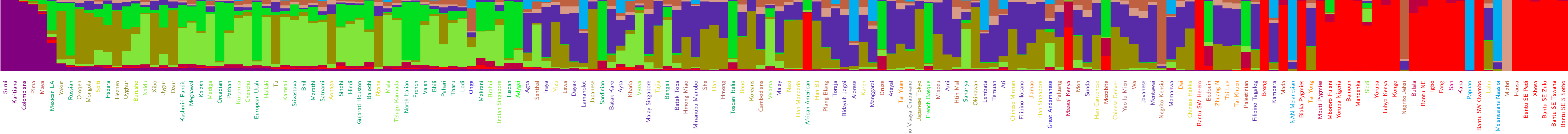
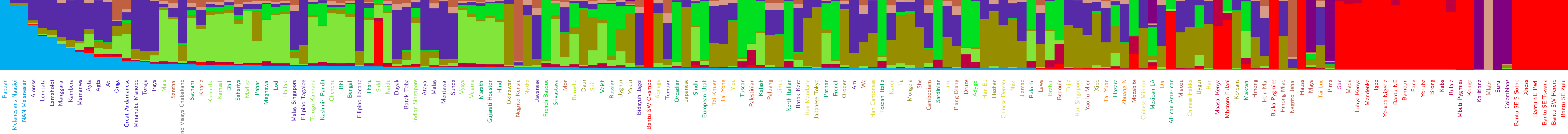


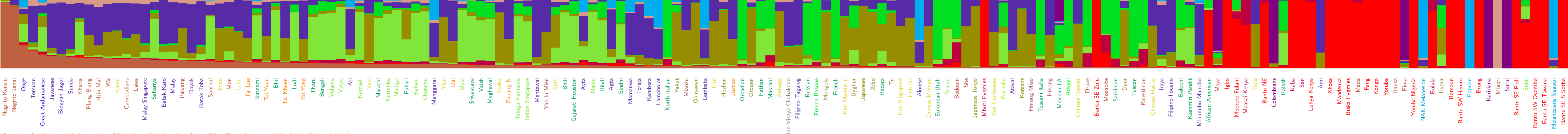
Ancestry class 10 is typical of population Surui from South America (speaking a Monde language of the family Tupi).



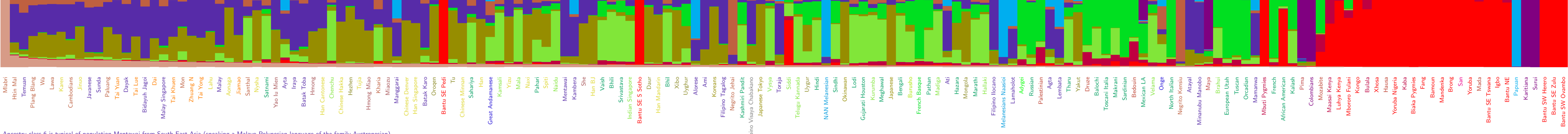
Ancestry class 9 is typical of population Papuan from Oceania (speaking a Ndu language of the family Sepik).



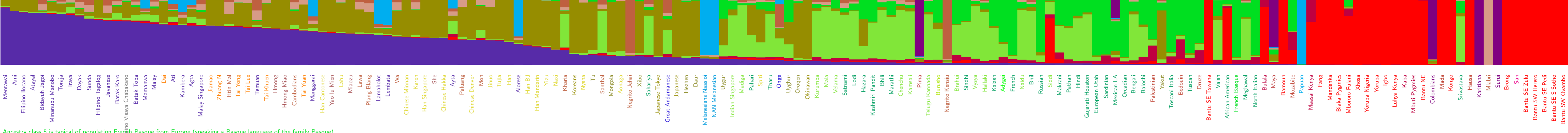
Ancestry class 8 is typical of population Negrito Kenui from South East Asia (speaking a Mon-Khmer language of the family Austro-Asiatic).



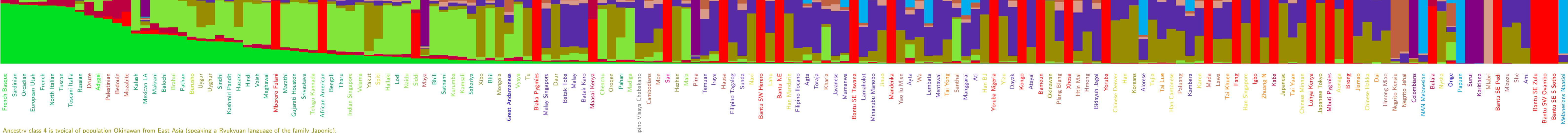
Ancestry class 7 is typical of population Mlabri from East Asia (speaking a Mon-Khmer language of the family Austro-Asiatic).



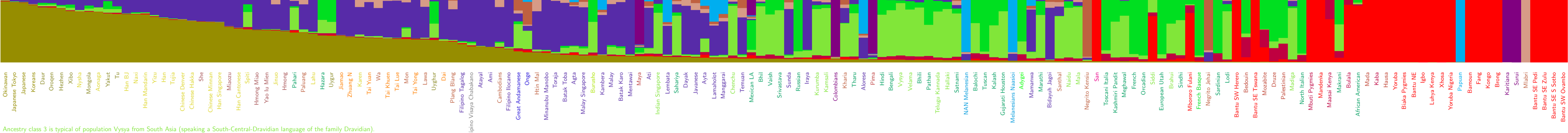
Ancestry class 6 is typical of population Mentawai from South East Asia (speaking a Malayo-Polynesian language of the family Austronesian).



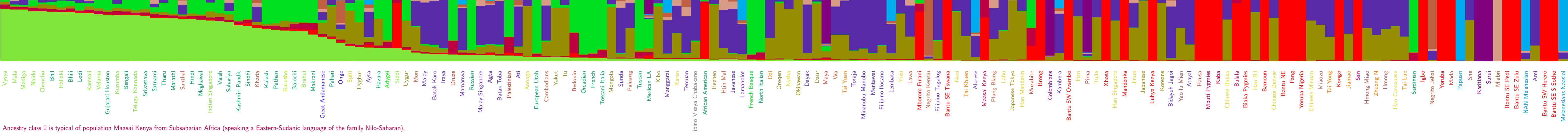

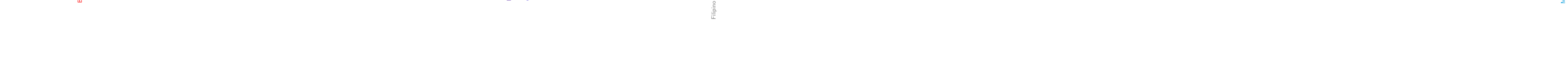
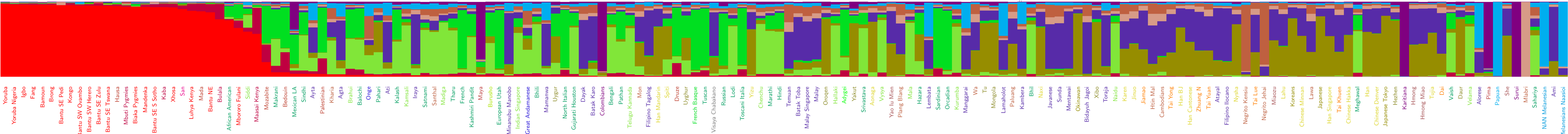
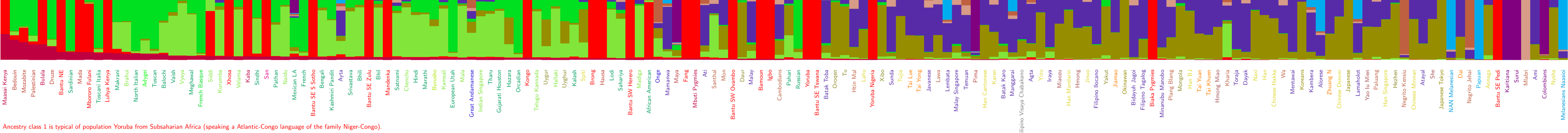
Ancestry class 4 is typical of population Okinawan from East Asia (speaking a Ryukyuan language of the family Japonic).
