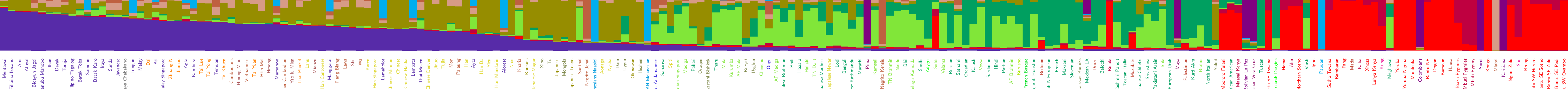
Ancestry class 8 has its highest proportion in Ngrto Keruu from South East Asia (speaking a Mon-Khmer language of the family Austro-Asiatic)



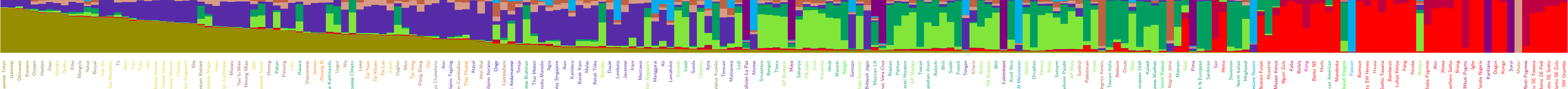
Ancestry class 7 has its highest proportion in Mlabri from East Asia (speaking a Mon-Khmer language of the family Austro-Asiatic)



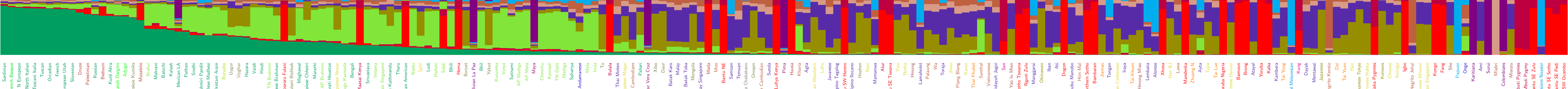
Ancestry class 6 has its highest proportion in Mentawai from South East Asia (speaking a Malayo-Polynesian language of the family Austronesian)



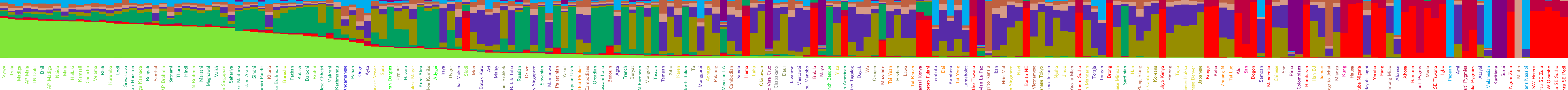
Ancestry class 5 has its highest proportion in Japanese from East Asia (speaking a Japanese language of the family Japonic)



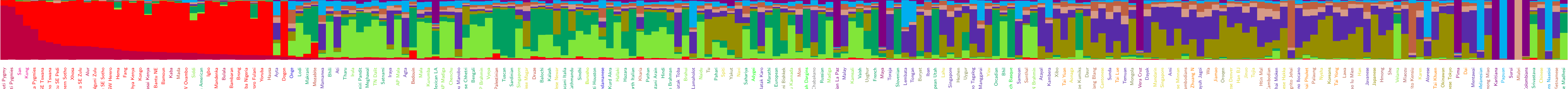

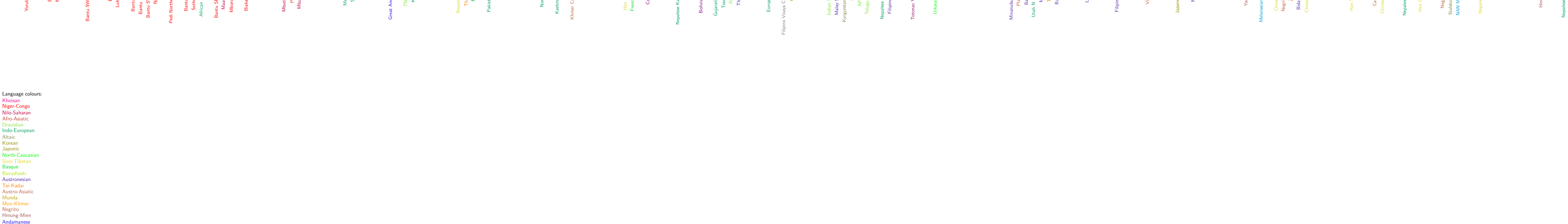
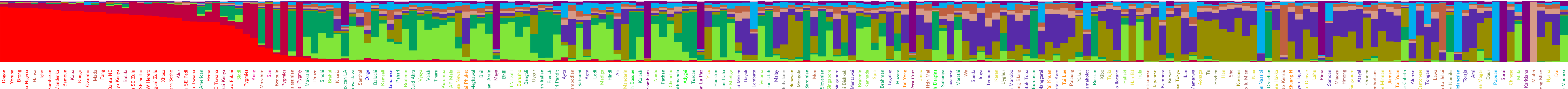
Ancestry class 3 has its highest proportion in Vyasa from South Asia (speaking a South-Central-Dravidian language of the family Dravidian)
