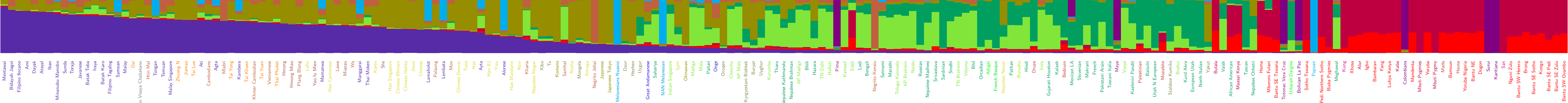
Ancestry class 8 has its highest proportion in Papuan from Oceania (speaking a Ndu language of the family Sepik)



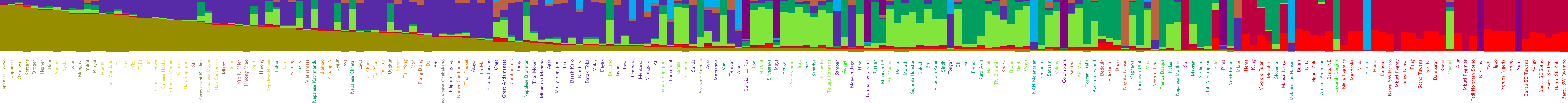
Ancestry class 7 has its highest proportion in Negrto Kenuis from South East Asia (speaking a Mon-Khmer language of the family Austro-Asiatic)



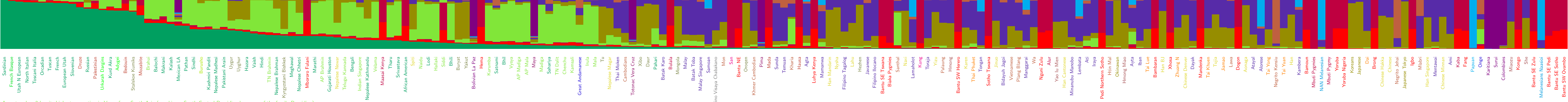
Ancestry class 6 has its highest proportion in Mentawai from South East Asia (speaking a Malayo-Polynesian language of the family Austronesian)



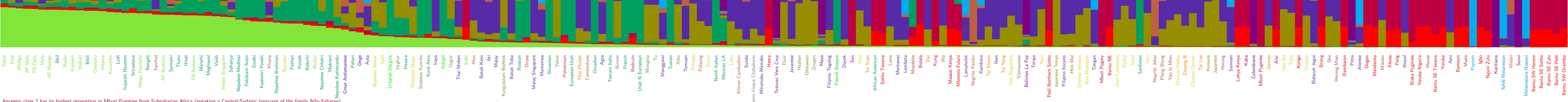
Ancestry class 5 has its highest proportion in Japanese Tokyujin from East Asia (speaking a Japanese language of the family Japonic)



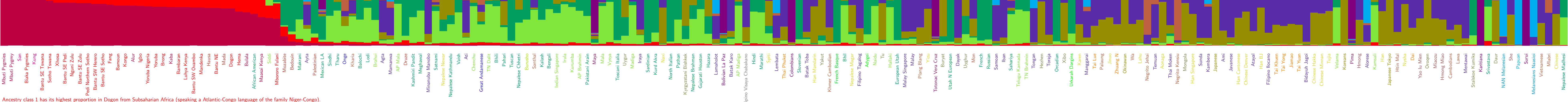
Ancestry class 4 has its highest proportion in Sardinian from South Europe (speaking a Italic language of the family Indo-European)



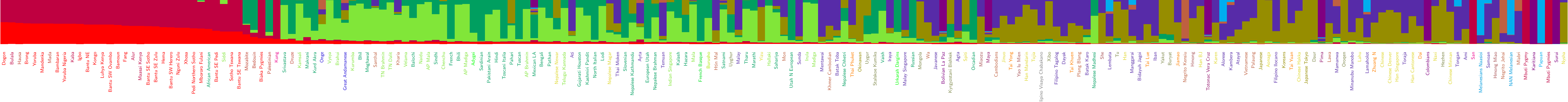
Ancestry class 3 has its highest proportion in Vayta from South Asia (speaking a South-Central-Dravidian language of the family Dravidian)
